High school enrollment is projected to be more than 6,600 students for 39 years



All three current high schools were built for a capacity of 1,600 students for a total design capacity of 4,800 students



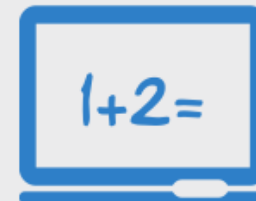
Operating levy portion will meet district's financial needs for at least three years



Allows district to hire & retain quality teachers & other personnel to meet the needs of the district's continuing enrollment growth



6.9 mills on this ballot issue will be approx \$241.50 per \$100,000 of home valuation



Operating levy will be used for day-to-day operations of our schools



The bond issue is to build a fourth high school, purchase the Olentangy Academy building, purchase buses & replace roofs as needed with **NO ADDITIONAL MILLAGE**



The permanent improvement levy (PI) will generate approx \$3.2 million annually for maintenance for district properties & upgrades & replacement costs for technology



A defeat could result in significant overcrowding, larger class sizes, and costly, temporary solutions to manage capacity
